## Getting to Eger from Budapest by public transport

 [Líceum, Eszterházy tér 1, Eger, 3300, Hungary](#)

**Train:** Take the train at Budapest, Keleti Pályaudvar and get off at Eger Train Station

- Duration: approx. 2 hours
- Walk 10 minutes to Líceum

**Bus:** Take the bus at Stadionok Volánbusz Buszpályaudvar

- Duration: approx. 2 hours
- Walk 5 minutes to Líceum

## Getting around the city

- **Bus:** buses run frequently (bus lines 11, 12, 14 also connect to the train and bus stations)
- **Taxi:** there are always taxis near the bus and train stations, and the taxi rank is behind our Líceum Building in the city centre  
→ in case: City Taxi Eger +36 36 555 555
- **Walking:** The historical centre is best explored on foot.

## Accommodation suggestions

- **Hotel Eger & Park\*\*\*** - A traditional hotel located next to the Gardonyi Geza Theatre in Eger's historical centre. It features a restaurant and a fully-equipped health centre with a gym. Free Wi-Fi is available.

- **Hotel Unicornis \*\*\*** - Affordable option in the city centre

- **1552 Boutique Hotel\*\*\*\*** - Located in Eger next to the city centre, it offers accommodation with a shared lounge, private parking, a terrace and a bar.

## Sightseeing

- **Dobó Square:** It is referred to as the heart of Eger, since it is really the centre of the town: all the major sights and monuments can be approached conveniently, with a few minutes' walk.

- **Castle of Eger:** You can learn about the history of the castle, and in the casemates you can discover everyday life in a border castle in the 16th century. On Calvary Hill you can enjoy the view. The castle is quite large, so you can explore it on your own or choose a tour led by warriors who will tell you many exciting stories.

- **Szépasszony Valley:** The No. 1 venue for wine tasting is Szépasszony Valley (Valley of the Beautiful Woman), about a 10-15 minute walk from the city centre. There are more than 150 cellars in the valley.

- **Basilica of Eger:** The Basilica of Eger is considered to be the second largest religious building in Hungary. The building is also the cathedral of the archdiocese of Eger.
