Bordeaux

As the capital of the [Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region](#), the city of Bordeaux enjoys a privileged position within France’s leading region for value-added agriculture. Farmland and forests here account for more than 80% of the territory.

Besides the world-renowned vineyards, [the city](#) has a number of fascinating museums, splendid architecture, culture, fame and outstanding cuisine.

In 2007 Bordeaux was added to the UNESCO World Heritage list as “an outstanding urban and architectural ensemble” of the 18th century, the largest urban area ever to receive this acclaim. It has become a very attractive area, has a unique lifestyle and the city’s exceptional vitality shows its openness to the world.



How to come in Bordeaux

- If **you fly**, [Bordeaux Mérignac Airport](#) will be your destination. It's connected with the public transport to get in the city centre.
- If **you travel by train**, [Bordeaux Saint-Jean](#) will be the **railway station** situated close to the city centre and connected with the public transport.

You can also fly to [Paris-Charles de Gaulle](#) (Roissy CDG) and take the TGV train from the airport (railway station: [Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 2TGV](#)) to Bordeaux Saint-Jean.

How to get in the city centre

TBM (Transport Bordeaux Métropole) is the company of the public transport in Bordeaux.

- You can check [the plan](#) on the website or on the app.
- **Tram F** is running from the airport **Bordeaux Mérignac** to the railway station **Bordeaux Saint-Jean**.
- Single ticket: 1.90€
- 10 journeys ticket: 15.70€
- All kinds of tickets and rates are available on the website and can be purchased [online](#), through the TBM app, at every tram or bus stop. Please keep the same ticket, you can charge new journeys on it.

How to find Bordeaux Sciences Agro

Bordeaux Sciencs Agro is situated on the large **campus Talence-Pessac-Gradignan**.

The address is [1 cours du Général de Gaulle, 33170 Gradignan](#) is but the main entrance is from the street “rue de Compostelle”.



You can come:

- By **Tram B** (direction Pessac Centre or France Alouette): stop **Doyen Brus** and 10 min. walk
- By **Bus n°31** (direction Gradignan Beausoleil): stop **Bardanac** and 10 min. walk
- By **Bus n°34** (from Peixotto – tram B – in the direction Mérignac Les Pins): stop **Compostelle** (just in front of the entrance of Bordeaux Sciences Agro)

Accommodation
